2)	Had they been waiting? [change from the interrogative to the affirmative form]
3)	We had been playing in the garden. [change from the affirmative to the negative form]
4)	I'm tired because I've been working a lot recently. [form the question that corresponds to this answer]
5)	She had been exercising for thirty minutes. [change from the affirmative to the interrogative form]
6)	He had been travelling. [change from the affirmative to the negative form]
7)	Before they arrived, I had been watching TV. [form the question that corresponds to this answer]
8)	Had they been trying to lose? [Answer this question in the negative]
9)	Had he been cleaning his room? [Answer this question in the affirmative]
10)	Yes, she had already been working as an artist. [form the question that corresponds to this answer]
