

Past Perfect: Exercise 1

- 1) He had already seen that film.
[change from the affirmative to the interrogative form]

- 2) Had they met before?
[change from the interrogative to the affirmative form]

- 3) We had prepared the meal beforehand.
[change from the affirmative to the negative form]

- 4) By the age of ten I had visited five cities.
[form the question that corresponds to this answer]

- 5) You had exercised earlier that morning.
[change from the affirmative to the interrogative form]

- 6) They had flown before.
[change from the affirmative to the negative form]

- 7) I hadn't been there earlier.
[form the question that corresponds to this answer]

- 8) Had you mentioned that before?
[Answer this question in the negative]

- 9) Had she understood the question?
[Answer this question in the affirmative]

- 10) No, she hadn't eaten that dish before.
[form the question that corresponds to this answer]
