### UNFINISHED TIMEFRAMES

**FOR:** Periods of time e.g. for 5 years

**SINCE:** Points in time e.g. since 1994

### QUESTIONS AND NEGATIVES

**ALREADY:** Affirmative statements e.g. I have already seen Titanic

**YET:** Questions and Negatives e.g. Have you been to London yet? / No, I haven't been to London yet.

### LIFE EXPERIENCES

**EVER:** Questions e.g. Has he ever played tennis?

**NEVER:** Negatives e.g. No, he has never played tennis.
