

Present Perfect Continuous: Exercise 1

- 1) They have been waiting all morning.
[change from the affirmative to the interrogative form]

- 2) Has he been working all day?
[change from the interrogative to the affirmative form]

- 3) She has been playing outside.
[change from the affirmative to the negative form]

- 4) Yes, I have been sleeping well recently.
[form the question that corresponds to this answer]

- 5) She has been doing yoga for many years.
[change from the affirmative to the interrogative form]

- 6) He has been watching TV.
[change from the affirmative to the negative form]

- 7) Before they arrived, I had been watching TV.
[form the question that corresponds to this answer]

- 8) Have they been trying to cheat?
[Answer this question in the negative]

- 9) Has he been tidying the apartment?
[Answer this question in the affirmative]

- 10) No, she hasn't been working there for long.
[form the question that corresponds to this answer]

Answers

- 1) Have they been waiting all morning?

- 5) Has she been doing yoga for many years?
- 6) He hasn't been watching TV.
- 7) What had you been doing before they arrived?
