2)	Has he been working all day? [change from the interrogative to the affirmative form]
 3)	She has been playing outside. [change from the affirmative to the negative form]
l)	Yes, I have been sleeping well recently. [form the question that corresponds to this answer]
5)	She has been doing yoga for many years. [change from the affirmative to the interrogative form]
5)	He has been watching TV. [change from the affirmative to the negative form]
')	Before they arrived, I had been watching TV. [form the question that corresponds to this answer]
3)	Have they been trying to cheat? [Answer this question in the negative]
))	Has he been tidying the apartment? [Answer this question in the affirmative]
(0)	No, she hasn't been working there for long. [form the question that corresponds to this answer]
