[form the question that corresponds to this answer]

- 5) The train arrives at 5.00 pm.
[change from the affirmative to the interrogative form]

- 6) She likes reading.
[change from the affirmative to the negative form]

- 7) I go jogging every morning **because** it's good for my health.
[form the question that corresponds to this answer]

- 8) Do they like pizza?
[Answer this question in the negative]

- 9) Does a centipede have a hundred legs?
[Answer this question in the affirmative]

- 10) I usually go shopping on Saturdays.
[form the question that corresponds to this answer]

- WHY? (motive)
WHERE? (place)
WHEN? (time)
HOW OFTEN? (frequency)
WHAT? (information)
